Crum's Heirlooms are family grown in Bonner Springs, KS where we are committed to sustainable agricultural practices using organic growing methods, promoting healthy eating by producing a large selection of veggies and herbs, and sharing information with the public about what we grow and how we grow it.

What is a CSA?

A CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) consists of a community of individuals who pledge support to a farm operation, with the growers and consumers providing mutual support and sharing the risks and benefits of a food production. (USDA) In addition to local, healthy, tasty produce, our members will receive a weekly newsletter with recipes and product information and invitations to special farm events such as the Farm Family Dinner.

How does it work?

Shares run for **21 weeks** beginning May 7 - September 24 for **\$242**
\$100 Deposits are due April 30 (deposits will be deducted from share price)
remaining balances are due upon your first pickup.

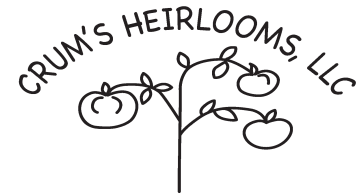
Refunds and Credits are not available

You are responsible for arranging that your share be picked up each week.
Shares will consist of an average of **4-6 items per week** totaling the \$11.52 per week cost. Our shares are of an ideal size for a two person or individual household.
Multiple shares may be purchased should you require larger product quantities.
Additional produce can be added for market price to your weekly share.
Safe-handling is our highest priority to ensure produce is at it's freshest.
We commit to do our best, in good faith, to provide shares with a variety of top quality produce for each week of the harvest season.
